

BVYC Assessment Proposal

The Finance Committee proposes an assessment to each active member of \$500 per year for the next 3 years to be billed August 1 of each year and due December 1 of each year. We look to generate an additional \$97,000 annually for the three years, which puts us in a healthy 1 to 1 income to expense ratio and will bring in an approximate total of \$291,000. The funds will be used to qualify for financing to fund capital improvements, assist in the replacement of our main docks and to consolidate existing and future debt for these projects.


